

# Interim Safety Training

Almost all safety training courses necessary for most work in the department of Materials Engineering are readily available. Most training courses are available on-line through Risk Management Services. The departmental safety orientation is available as a video presentation through the [mtrl.ubc.ca](http://mtrl.ubc.ca) website safety page. In general, only the practical session for the chemical safety course might be somewhat delayed. If it is necessary to begin research work before this session can be completed then the supervisor is required to provide interim training (the RMS practical session must still be completed). Chemical storage compatibility and spill clean-up procedures are major topics of this practical session. The supervisor then should assess what aspects of this training may be pertinent for his/her lab, and then provide suitable instruction.

**Note that work with radioactive materials may NOT be undertaken prior to passing the radiation safety course.**
